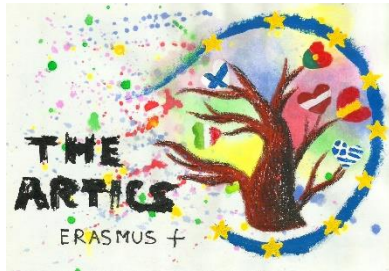

OBJECTIVES	<p>The main objectives of the second Transnational Project Meeting were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• make a presentation on national traditional cuisines,</li> <li>• creative cooking workshop: each partner can cook traditional recipes in the school kitchen facilities or bring traditional food,</li> <li>• each partner had to prepare a draft of a single act on gender violence to be played by his team in Portugal as part of a collaborative show.
